- Public Forum: Trees down on East Skyline Court
- Drainage issues
 - Jim Attarian supervised Jetter Clean Clearing 3 tile lines (3x in last 13 months). Tile #1 was okay and is 8" tile. Tile #2 was fully blocked to West Skyline Court. Tile #3 was clear. The last time they were cleaned were October 24th 2024 (the annual cleaning) and before that in July 2024.
 - Tile line from home to main lines are homeowner responsibility
 - Main tile lines are responsibility of city or TBD
 - Plan to publicize the tile line diagram
 - Add a Jetter Clean date Spring/early summer
 - Obtain a cost estimate to replace/repair tile line not bidding the job yet
 - Question the need for holding ponds
 - Roof drainage cannot go into the tile line

- Joanne Boettcher is a water resource engineer. State funding was applied for. Engineering study cost \$30,000-50,000 and install estimate is \$200,000+
- Planting changes to help versus turf grass
- Can we just replace the problem 650' on line #2?
- Size up the lines
- City of Skyline to call in resources to find and assess problems. Then figure out restrictions and limitations (sizing up). From there, determine the cost and where the funding can come from
