Water Service Line

REMINDER: Residents are asked to send a picture of their water supply line coming out of the floor of their home and email that picture with your house address to the City of Skyline Clerk at Skylineclerk@gmail.com so that it can be identified and registered with the state. Once you have completed this, you will no longer need to receive this letter and we are closer to completing our requirement of 100% of the homes identifying their service lines. Pictures need to be submitted by the end of June. PLEASE SEND YOUR PICTURE IF YOU HAVE NOT ALREADY!

This is a mandatory requirement for residents. If you are unable to locate your water service line or need help taking a photo, please email skylineclerk@gmail.com or call 507-317-7291.

Other Open Positions

The City of Skyline is looking to find residents to fill two other very important positions.

Pumphouse Reader: Physically go to the pumphouse at the park everyday on your assigned months (December, April, August) to record the water and chemical amounts used. Other monitoring tasks regarding operations of the pumphouse as well. Pay is \$240/year paid in December.

City Hall Cleaner: Cleaning was typically completed at least twice a month, with additional cleanings scheduled if there was an event taking place. Each cleaning session usually lasted no longer than an hour and a half.
